GENERAL STORE HOURS: In season, 8 A.M.-5 P.M. Monday-Saturday. 8 A.M.-3 P.M. Sunday. Off season, will be posted on the door. After hours number is 423-784-9445. For emergencies call 911.

CHECK IN: 3 P.M. You may arrive early and use our temporary parking area and access the trails, if you have registered at the general store.

CHECK OUT: 11:00 A.M. Our cleaning crews will arrive at 11:00 A.M. We ask that you vacate by 11:00 A.M. and return keys to the general store. Another day's rental will be charged to your folio by 12:00 P.M. You are welcome to use the resort facilities and parking lot to trail ride, after check out.

CABINS: All dishes should be washed and returned to cabins. All trash removed. Lights, T.V. and appliances should be turned off. Doors locked and keys returned to office.

RESTAURANT: Serves a hearty southern breakfast buffet along with supper. Hours are 8 A.M.-10:30 A.M. and 6 P.M.-8:30 P.M. Reservations are not necessary.

- ✓ **PETS:** There are many things to consider in allowing pets into a resort. Such as noise, pet hair, fleas, ticks, and allergies to future guests. Therefore, we will only allow pets in the RV area. Pets must be on leash when outside. If pets are found inside a cabin, we will charge your folio a cleaning fee of \$200. _____ (initials)
- ✓ **SMOKING:** Cabins are 100% smoke free. If our policy is violated or if a smoke detector/alarm has been disabled or removed, we will charge your folio a \$200 environmental cleaning fee. _____ (initials)
- ✓ **NOISE:** Do not play music so loudly that it disturbs other guests. Obey **QUIET TIME** from 11 P.M.-8 A.M. _____ (initials)
- ✓ **CHILDREN:** Parents please attend to your children. RRB works to maintain a family atmosphere for everyone's enjoyment. It is strongly recommended that parents obey the manufacturer's guidelines in age appropriate OHV's for their children. **DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO CRUISE THE CAMPGROUND AS ENTERTAINMENT.** This causes dust and poses a risk for property damage. Please remember, all children under age 18 are required to wear a helmet. _____ (initials)

CABINS: Remove muddy shoes at the door. Do not get mud on the carpets, walls, furniture, or ceiling. Do not use our linens to clean mud from shoes or OHV's. Do not rearrange cabin or deck furniture. Failure to obey these rules will cause your folio to be charged a labor fee.

TOWEL EXCHANGES: Towels and wash cloths can be exchanged at the general store. You must turn in soiled for clean. Extra toiletries, toilet paper and garbage bags are also available.

REFUSE: ALL TRASH must be disposed into the nearest dumpster. Do not leave trash inside the cabins. Do not throw trash/beer cans into the fire rings or the yard. We will charge your folio \$40 for trash removal.

FIREWOOD: Can be purchased at the general store. Fires are permitted but it is your responsibility to control. Unused firewood must be removed at check out. Any logs, branches or debris dragged into campsite and left behind will be removed at your expense.

ALCOHOL: Is allowed at campsites. No open containers or driving/operating a vehicle inside the campground. No carry in at lodge/restaurant.

FUEL: High octane gasoline is available at the general store.

We ask that you respect these guidelines. Guest that arrive late to your group, MUST REGISTER at the general store. Extra guests in the RV sites will be charged \$5 per day, per guest (children excluded). Extra tents in RV sites or at cabins will be charged \$20 per day. ONE CAMPER PER RV SITE. NO CAMPERS ALLOWED AT CABINS.

TRAILER PARKING: Do not block driveways or roads. There is extra parking in the stage area. One vehicle per RV site. Two per cabin site. ALL OTHERS MUST PARK IN THE STAGE AREA.

PICNIC TABLES: Every site and cabin has a picnic table. If you move tables together for groups, be sure and return the table before check out in order to avoid a charge to your folio.

CELL PHONES: Most cell phones work in the resort and WMA. A phone is available in the general store for emergency use only.

EMERGENCIES: Call 911. Our address is 6307 Stinking Creek Rd. Pioneer, TN 37847.

TRAILS: There are over 600 miles of trails connecting to the Royal Blue/Sundquist/New River area. Free trail maps are available at the general store. Remember to stay on the trails and gravel roads. Do not cut new trails OR DRIVE OVER THE RESORT GRASSY LAWNS. The speed limits on the trails is 25 MPH and inside the campground is 10 MPH.

RIDING ON PAVED ROADS: It is not legal to operate an OHV on a paved road in the State of Tennessee. You are allowed to cross a road but always yield to traffic and operate your OHV in a safe and slow manner. DO NOT RACE ON THE ROADWAYS.
